Standing Committees

External Engagement. The committee serves as a strategic forum to review, assess and advance issues related to Duke University's external relations. These include the university's practices and policies with regard to marketing and brand management, and engagement with alumni, donors, federal, state, and local governments, the community, partners (corporations, foundations, NGOs, etc.), policymakers, media, and the public at large. Resources. The committee oversees the financial, physical, technological, and human resources of the university.

Student Members: 1 Undergraduate, 1 Graduate or Professional

Undergraduate Education. The committee oversees the academic, social, ethical, and personal development of undergraduate students. It oversees and recommends policies—as formulated by the senior administration—related to the undergraduate experience, including academic studies; curriculum; residence life; student governance and activities; and the general physical, psychological, and spiritual well-being of undergraduate students.

<u>Student Members: 2 Undergraduate</u> (The DSG President is automatically appointed to one of the two student seats on the Undergraduate Education Committee.)
