Standing Committees

External Engagement. The committee serves as a strategic forum to review, assess and advance issues related to Duke University's external relations. These include the university's practices and policies with regard to marketing and brand management, and engagement with alumni, donors, federal, state, and local governments, the community, partners (corporations, foundations, NGOs, etc.), policymakers, media, and the public at large.

Student Members: 1 Undergraduate, 1 Graduate or Professional

Finance. The committee oversees the financial and capital resources of the university. The committee exercises oversight of the university's financial stability and long-term financial health and is expected to understand and monitor the related risk profile. The committee serves as the board's principal forum for the consideration of matters relating to the university's finances. On a regular basis, the committee provides the board with updates on the university's financial position and overall health and well as updates on the university's operating and capital budgets and related performance. The committee exercises oversight to ensure that the university has the resources necessary to support its mission and priorities.

Student Members: 1 Undergraduate, 1 Graduate or Professional

Undergraduate Education. The committee oversees the academic, social, ethical, and personal development of undergraduate students. It oversees and recommends policies—as formulated by the senior administration—related to the undergraduate experience, including academic studies; curriculum; residence life; student governance and activities; and the general physical, psychological, and spiritual well-being of undergraduate students.

Student Members: 2 Undergraduate (*The DSG President is automatically appointed to one of the two student seats on the Undergraduate Education Committee.*)
